DESCRIPTION

EXPRESS YOURSELF AND YOUR INNER ARTIST WITH OIL PASTELS BY USING NEW BLENDING TECHNIQUES YOU CAN GAIN WHILE WATCHING THIS WEEK'S DEMONSTRATION VIDEO WITH TEEN WORKER, CARMEN. (Note: Not all the colors distributed in kits will be the same as the video demo).

GOALS AND REFLECTION

1. Complete your rough draft ideas.
2. Begin to paint your cardstock with pastels.
 - Paint from the bottom of the page to the top, lightest pastels to darkest.
 - **CAUTION: BE SURE TO SAVE YOUR DARKEST PASTEL COLOR FOR THE SILHOUTTES.**
3. Begin to blend with your coffee filter. Blending from lightest to darkest (bottom to top).
4. Paint a silhouette drawing of whatever you would like using the darkest pastel you have.
5. Optional: To keep the pastels locked into the painting, you can hairspray the picture. You're done!
