Hey 4-H! We hope you are having a great summer so far! This week we bring home this fun and easy craft to make your own crown! Have a blast!

DESCRIPTION

BE THE KING OR QUEEN YOU ARE BY CREATING A CROWN USING FUN CRAFT SUPPLIES AND YOUR MIND'S CREATIVITY! A LIGHT AND UPBEAT CRAFT GIVEN FOR YOUR SATISFACTION!

DIRECTIONS

1. Take all the materials out of the bag. Supply your own glue and coloring materials.
2. Fit the crown around your head, but do not staple or glue the crown together until after your decorating project is finished. (If the crown is too small to wrap around your head, you can add paper of your own as an extension).
3. Lay the crown on a hard surface and put together your crown using glue and all the crafting materials!
4. After you allow your crown to dry (from gluing) you can measure it to your head. Feel free to make adjustments.
