3. A paper signed by school official certifying grade point minimum of 2.0 – no mention of actual grade point average may be made anywhere in application.
4. Three letters of recommendation.
5. One copy of applicant’s “My 4-H Livestock Story”. Applicant’s story should not exceed six typewritten, double-spaced pages and should follow this format:
 - Introduce yourself and your family
 - Discuss your involvement in 4-H livestock programs, emphasizing your skill and leadership development.
 - Tell how your 4-H experiences have contributed to personal growth and improved family living and community betterment.
 - Outline your future plans and tell how 4-H has affect these plans
 - Describe any lasting effect your 4-H experience might have on your life, now and in the future
