On behalf of Kodiak 4-H program, Adult Leaders & Council, I would like to welcome you to our program. For those returning families, thank you for your continued support and program loyalty. We are excited about the new 4-H year, and hope you are too!

As a Kodiak 4-H Community Club member, your child belongs to a local group of school-age boys and girls looking for fun projects and new friendships. A primary focus of 4-H participation is "Learn by Doing", so your child will be introduced to life skills programs at beginner levels as well as more advanced levels. The Kodiak Community club meets as a whole monthly and for various events throughout the year, and cloverbuds will be meeting at least monthly, separate from the bigger group.

On the following page, you will see a list of basic requirements that every 4-H cloverbud member (ages 5-8) is asked to complete in order to earn a certificate of achievement. Our Annual Achievement Banquet is held at the end of every 4-H year, which runs from October 1st – September 30th. Some of our other projects have age restrictions due to insurance purposes, so once enrolled in cloverbuds, if your child is interested in other projects, contact me to find out if it is age appropriate.

Kodiak 4-H Requirements for Cloverbuds

- Be an enrolled member of 4-H in Alaska
- Attend 6 project meetings or ten hours cumulative hours
- Complete a cloverbud record book
- Volunteer at two fundraising events
 - Harvest Festival: October 21st, 2017
 - Pancake Breakfast: Memorial Day
- Display at least one project exhibit at the Kodiak State Fair, held at the end of August or beginning of September each year.

The following criteria, though not mandatory, should be encouraged as a Kodiak 4-H member:

- Attendance at monthly All Member Meetings/ Event Nights (held the 2nd Monday of each month from November – May, excluding March).
 - Meetings take place at the Kodiak Middle School Commons at 6 PM
 - Locations for the Event Nights will be announced closer to the date
- Attendance at all 4-H events when possible (parade group, etc.)
- Attendance/volunteering at Kodiak 4-H Cloverbud Camp
